VISA REGIME

In 2018, Belarus extended the visa-free stay for foreigners to 30 days. Visa-free visits are provided on condition of the entrance through the National Airport Minsk for citizens of 74 countries, including European countries, as well as Brazil, Indonesia, the United States, Japan and other countries.

PETROCHEMICAL COMPLEX OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

The petrochemical complex of the Republic of Belarus includes organizations for the extraction, refining and transportation of oil, chemistry and petrochemistry enterprises, as well as a number of scientific, design, construction, repair and commissioning organizations. The most of them are united by the Belarusian State Concern for Oil and Chemistry (Belneftekhim Concern). Organizations of the Belneftekhim Concern (19 legal entities) form about 20% of the industrial production of the Republic of Belarus and 25% of the export of goods, provide about 20% of revenues and produce over 500 of budget types petrochemical and chemical products, which are exported than 100 countries. In foreign markets to more the Belneftekhim Concern is represented by a wide distribution network. The main exports are crude oil and petroleum products, mineral fertilizers, tires, caprolactam, polyethylene, chemical fibers and threads. In the Republic of Belarus the enterprises for the extraction, transportation, refining of oil production of chemical and petrochemical and the products are closely linked by the production chains and ties. The above ties contribute cooperative to the coordinated development, meeting the needs for the raw materials for the production of chemical products, increase competitiveness the foreign in markets of the and minimization of the commercial risks.

MARKET REVIEW AND OUTLOOK

ABS plastic is used for the production of automobile, radio engineering, and instrument-making industry products, internal parts of refrigerators, medical products, and consumer goods. In 2018 the global production capacity of ABS plastic was estimated at 10.4 million tons per year. The Asia-Pacific region is dominating in the market. It is expected that the development of infrastructure, especially in countries such as China and India, as well as the growth of the home appliances market will increase the demand for ABS plastic in this region.

According to the forecasts, the capacity of ABS plastic production will reach 11.8 million tons per year by 2023. In the short term, the capacity growth is predicted in China, Indonesia, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Mexico, and India. The largest players in the global ABS plastic market are INEOS Group, Chi Mei Corporation, Formosa Chemicals&Fibre Corp., PetroChina Company Limited, LG Chem. In 2019 the global export of ABS plastics reached the level of 7.9 billion USD.
